

**Erin Hager, CFE, CPA** is a senior auditor in the Arizona Auditor General's Special Investigative Unit. The Special Investigative Unit investigates allegations of illegal acts that affect public monies, and assists law enforcement agencies with criminal and civil prosecution of suspects. In the past ten fiscal years, the Special Investigative Unit has completed 34 investigations, discovered over \$6.7 million of theft or misuse of public monies, and over \$4.3 million in conflict of interest and procurement violations.

Erin earned her bachelor's degree in accounting from Arizona State University. Her professional experience prior to becoming a certified fraud examiner includes performance auditing, internal auditing, employee training, and office administration. She has conducted numerous internal training sessions, as well as fraud presentations for universities and professional associations.
